COMBATING FAILURE IN EDUCATION - THE IDEA BEHIND THE PROJECT

Our mission is to use the potential of performing arts to help most marginalised adults gain professional competences they are struggling to get.

Nowadays, in Europe, there are still almost 70 million adults with only lower secondary level qualifications, approximately 20 million of whom have not even achieved this grade.

It doesn't look better if we will take in consideration also migrant situation - average number of years of schooling for the vast majority of migrants is half the EU value.

In this project we are aiming to address the needs of the most difficult to access adult groups - people who don't want to learn or are unable to learn sub-set. The ARTISTIC LICENCE PROJECT is addressing this disadvantage, **combating failure in education and enhancing pedagogic and didactic approaches in adult education to engage the most marginalised adults especially those with a migrant background.** We are aware that often this task, which might be considered the most difficult educational assignment when it comes to adult education is left to the tutors with the least qualifications and little access to continuous professional development supports.


WHAT DO WE WANT TO ACHIEVE?

During the next months we are going to:


- Continue working on **Intellectual Output 1 – Building Basic Skills Toolkit** – compendium of resources using performing arts to help marginalized adults
