

WELCOME TO THE 3rd NEWSLETTER OF THE NEET SYSTEM PROJECT

For attracting young people who had previous negative educational experience, or early school-leavers who have failed to complete their formal education, NEET SYSTEM consortium have prepared and developed a suite of educational materials and resources to support educators addressing their needs.

As part of Intellectual output #1 partners have been working in groups developing 32 escape room resources. Resources were developed at 4 different levels: **Introductory, Intermediate, Advanced and Expert level** with 2 resources per competence:

As part of Intellectual output #2 partners have developed In service Training programme and Handbook addressing the innovative pedagogic methodologies for providing training in dynamic, online environments and for building learning tools based on educational escape room challenges

As part of Intellectual output #3, an online learning portal is developed as a one-stop-shop providing instant access to the full suite of online educational escape room learning resources.

As part of Intellectual output #4, Policy paper is going to be produced as this model could have considerable bearing on future policy development by bringing education and training to NEETs in digital and social media environments.

TEACHER TRAINING IN LANCASTER, UK



20 hours training program for **2 educators** from each partner country was held from **27 to 29 January 2020** in Lancaster, UK



supporting them to develop the necessary pedagogic skills and competences to deliver training in dynamic online environment, and to develop their own online escape room challenge-based learning resources.

FINAL CONFERENCE

- will be organized in Germany and hosted by project coordinator, JFV-PCH in July / August 2020
